Priority gifts are: underwear for men and women, t-shirts for men and women L and XL, white socks, washable pants or jeans, thermal tops and bottoms, L & up and sweatshirts.

Other needs include: bar soap, shampoo, lotion, tooth brushes, tooth paste, laundry detergent, disposable razors, petroleum jelly, feminine napkins, towels and wash cloths, gift cards to Grocery Stores, etc.

TENDER MERCIES: Tender Mercies is located at 27 West 12th Street. It provides housing and related services to homeless persons with histories of emotional and/or mental disabilities.
