Deficits were primarily offset with FPF Cash Reserves after Parish Debt was paid off

- Sundays and Holy days are up \$17,400 over last year and \$4,200 over budget. It is worth noting that the total collection is \$42,000 less than two years ago
- Bequest revenue was \$31,500 which was \$20,000 higher than budget and \$92,000 less than the previous year
- Enrollment is currently 350 vs. LY 383
- Tuition revenue has declined significantly
- Cash Reserves were used to finance the deficit
