The new Eucharistic Ministers' schedule is ready for pick up in the sacristy.

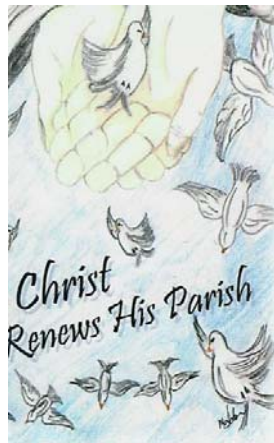
